



## LEVEL 2 AWARD IN MENTORING

### **Qualification Aim**

This qualification allows disabled learners to gain a deeper understanding of the role of a mentor and develop the skills needed to become an effective mentor. The aims of the qualification are to help learners gain an insight in to the role and practice of being a mentor, to be clear about mentor/mentee relationships, ensure good practice, develop specific skills and understanding, reflect on own learning and performance, understand the benefits of mentoring and the legal and ethical requirements

#### **Qualification Structure**

Unit 01 - Role of a Mentor

Understand the role and benefits of mentoring, be able to identify how a mentoring agreement works and be aware of how mentors are managed and supported

#### Unit 02 - Preparing for the Role of a Mentor

Understand the skills and tools required by a mentor, be aware of how to develop their own skills and understand the legal and ethical requirements of mentoring

#### **Unit 03 - Demonstrating Mentoring Skills and Techniques**

Understand how to prepare for a mentoring meeting, undertake an assessor observed mentoring meeting and review own performance as a mentor
