



Level 2 in Mentoring qualification

Communication Matters has been successful in receiving a grant from Awards for All (Big Lottery) to deliver **Level 2 in Mentoring** qualification

'Mentoring is a way of giving time and support to another person to help them make changes in their lives. Mentors will have had relevant life experience and an understanding of what another young person is going through or what their concerns are. It is a purposeful relationship in which both the mentor and the young person can benefit and requires good understanding of the skills required to mentor in order for the mentoring relationship to be the best that it can be'

This is very exciting as we know that many disabled young people would welcome the opportunity to be supported by another disabled young person who understands their concerns and aspirations and who may be able to spend time working together.

The funding is limited to a small group of disabled young people who are currently fulfilling the role of a mentor or who would like to develop their skills and understanding in readiness to mentor.

The qualification consist of three units (please see attached information sheet) and we are able to fund the workshops, qualification registration, assessment and certificates along with a small travel allowance to help with travel costs.
