How to join the AAC Forum

Send a blank email to:

cm-aac-forum+subscribe@googlegroups.com

You will receive an email from Google.

Click on the button 'Join this Group' in the email.

A Google page will open asking you to sign in.

If you already have a Google account, sign in as usual.

If you do not have a Google account, click on the 'Sign up' button at the top right to create an account.

You will then receive an email from Google to confirm your account.

You can now go to the [AAC Forum home](#) web page.

You will be able to read previous posts or post to the group.

You can also post a message to the group by sending an email to cm-aac-forum@googlegroups.com.
