ISAAC (International Society for Augmentative and Alternative Communication) is a worldwide organisation that works for **AAC** users.

AAC is used to mean many different ways to help someone communicate. It could be simple things like pointing, signing, writing or drawing. It could also be using a special device like a machine that ‘speaks’ words for you.

ISAAC began in 1983 and now has thousands of members in 50 countries.

There are 15 groups in different countries.

They have a newsletter and run a conference every 2 years.

Communication Matters is the UK part of ISAAC. All our members automatically become members of ISAAC.
