Qualification aim:

This qualification provides learners with an understanding of the role of a mentor and an awareness of the skills needed to become an effective mentor

Qualification structure:

The course is delivered over four days (see dates) and includes:

Unit 01 Role of a mentor:

Understand the role of a mentor, the reasons for an agreement between the mentor and how to identify the support available to a mentor

Unit 02 Preparing for the role of a mentor:

Understand key factors relating to mentoring, be aware of the main tools used by mentors and how to develop the skills to become a mentor

Unit 03 Demonstrating mentoring skills and techniques:

Prepare for a mentoring meeting, undertake an observed mentoring meeting and review own performance as a mentor
